PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a burglary/assault that occurred in 3500 block of St. Paul Street (between University Parkway & 34th Street) on September 22, 2022 at approximately 3:30 AM. An affiliate victim was awoken by an unidentified suspect in her bedroom. The victim screamed and the suspect ran out of the apartment in an unknown direction. The apartment building and surrounding area was checked for the suspect with negative results. There was physical contact between the victim and suspect, however the victim was not injured.

Suspect Description

Male, medium build, short hair, shirtless and possibly wearing shorts.
