PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a Commercial Armed Robbery that occurred at 3003 N. Charles Street (7-11 Convenience Store) on January 24, 2023, at about 3:20pm. At this time, a male suspect entered the store and approached the cashier. The suspect implied that he had a weapon and demanded money. The cashier complied with the suspect's demand. The suspect subsequently departed and was last seen walking eastbound on E. 30th Street.

Suspect Description:

Male, wearing black mask, green/black jacket, dark long sleeve shirt, dark pants, black shoes and carrying a white plastic bag

NOTE: Upon departing the store, the suspect removed his jacket and mask.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
