PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a Commercial Armed Robbery that occurred at 3003 N. Charles Street (7-11 Convenience Store) on January 11, 2023, at about 12:10 am. At that time, a male suspect entered the store and approached the clerk. He then implied he had a weapon and he said, "Give me the money from the register." The Store Clerk complied, and the suspect was given money and six packs of cigarettes. The suspect fled the area on foot. The Clerk sustained no injuries.

Suspect Description: Black/male, 6'1, medium build, early 30's, wearing a dark skull cap, a black mask that covered his nose and mouth, a black hoodie with the letters "SR" on the front in white lettering and light blue jeans

Campus Security would like all JHU affiliates to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
