Baltimore Police are currently investigating two off-campus incidents that occurred in the Charles Village area:

Commercial Armed Robbery

On January 20, 2023, at about 1:40PM, a male subject entered Motzi Bread, located at 2801 Guilford Avenue and implied that he had a weapon. The subject demanded money and the employee complied. Upon taking the money, the subject departed. The subject was last seen running northbound on Hunter Street.

Subject Description: male, tall, wearing a maroon hooded sweatshirt, jeans and a black mask

Commercial Attempted Armed Robbery

On January 20, 2023, at about 2:40PM, a male subject entered Orient Express, located at 3111 St. Paul Street and implied that he had a weapon. The subject demanded money and the employees did not comply. The subject subsequently departed and was last seen running northbound on St. Paul Street.

Subject Description: male, 5'10", thin, wearing a black sweatshirt, khaki pants and carrying a maroon and black book bag

There were no injuries sustained in either incident.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of these incidents and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
