PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police and Public Safety are currently investigating an Armed Robbery that occurred in the area of 7 East 33rd Street, on April 22, 2023, at about 8:20 pm. At that time, a male suspect approached a JHU Affiliate. The suspect told the affiliate to give him his cell phone, while displaying what appeared to be a razorblade. The Affiliate complied and gave the suspect his cell phone. The suspect then made several electronic cash transactions on the victim's phone. After which, the suspect then fled the area on foot heading eastbound on 33rd Street.

Suspect Description: Black/male, 6'0, thin build, early 20's, dreads and a beard was wearing gray sweatpants and a gray hoodie.

Campus Security would like all JHU affiliates to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
