PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a robbery that occurred near 3100 Hargrove Street on May 9, 2023, at approximately 12:45AM. At this time, two male subjects approached a non-affiliate victim. The subjects pushed the victim to the ground and forcibly took their purse. The subjects fled east on 31st Street toward Guilford Avenue. No weapons were displayed and the victim was not injured during the incident.

Suspect Descriptions:

Two males, wearing dark clothing

Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
