PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating an armed robbery that occurred in the 800 block of E. 33rd Street on May 19, 2023, at approximately 10:47 AM. At the aforementioned time, three male subjects approached an affiliate and one of the suspects implied he was armed. One of the suspects removed the affiliate's cellphone from their pocket. The subjects fled west on 33rd Street toward Ellerslie Avenue. There were no injuries reported at the scene.

Suspect Descriptions:

Suspect #1 Male, blue jeans, multi-color hoodie.

Suspect #2 Male, all black clothing, black mask.

Suspect #3 Male, blue jeans, blue hoodie, blue mask.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
