PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a Commercial Armed Robbery that occurred at 3233 St. Paul Street (Subway) on August 17, 2023, at about 4:25 AM. A male suspect entered the store and approached the cashier. The suspect was armed with a black handgun demanded the cashier open the cash register and safe. The suspect removed the money from the cash drawer and was given money from the safe. The suspect subsequently departed and was last seen walking eastbound on E. 33rd Street.

Suspect Description:

Male, 30-40 years old, 140-160 lbs., wearing a black ski mask, black shirt, black pants, black bag, armed with a black handgun.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
