PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a robbery that occurred in the 3100 block of Hargrove Street, on September 15, 2024, at about 7:00AM. At this time, two non-affiliates were walking along Hargrove Street, toward 31st Street when they were approached by an SUV-type vehicle, white in color.

As the vehicle reached the non-affiliates location, it stopped in the roadway. Five subjects exited the vehicle and approached the non-affiliates. At this time, the subjects demanded one non-affiliate's cell phone and they complied. Both non-affiliates were assaulted and suffered minor injuries during the incident.

All five subjects subsequently re-entered the vehicle, and it was last seen traveling southbound on Hargrove Street.

Suspect Descriptions:

Five males, 15-18 years of age, wearing dark clothing

Suspect Vehicle Description:

White SUV-type vehicle

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
