PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are investigating an unarmed robbery that occurred on September 29, 2024, at approximately 11:00pm, in the 500-blk W. University Parkway. An affiliate was walking in the area when they were approached by six male juveniles who exited a white Hyundai. The juveniles chased the affiliate and the affiliate fell to the ground. The juveniles punched the affiliate and took his backpack. The presence of Public Safety officers, who were patrolling the area, interrupted the robbery. Upon looking in the direction of the Public Safety officers, the juveniles ran to their vehicle and fled eastbound on University Parkway. The affiliate sustained minor injuries.

Suspects' Description

6 male juveniles, 15-18 years old, wearing ski masks and dark clothing.

Vehicle Description

A white color Hyundai
