PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating an unarmed robbery that occurred in the 100 block of W. 39th Street, on November 11, 2024, at about 2:40AM. At this time, an affiliate was walking along 39th Street, toward Canterbury Road when they were approached by a small passenger vehicle, black in color.

As the vehicle reached the affiliate's location, it stopped in the roadway. Two subjects exited the vehicle and approached the affiliate. At this time, the subjects demanded the affiliate's property, and they complied.

The two subjects subsequently re-entered the vehicle, and it was last seen traveling eastbound on W. 39th Street. No injuries were sustained during the incident.

Suspect Descriptions:

Two males, wearing dark clothing and face masks

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
