PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Public Safety received a report of an attempt armed robbery in the area of 34th Street and St. Paul Street on November 16, 2024 at approximately 3:00AM. Affiliate victims were walking in the area when they were approached by a gray car. Four male subjects exited the vehicle. One of the subjects displayed a handgun and demanded their property. The affiliates fled the area. There were no injuries sustained during this incident.

Suspect Descriptions:

Four males, wearing all black clothing and ski masks, 18-21 years of age. Last seen driving a gray vehicle.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
