PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are investigating an unarmed robbery that occurred on November 19, 2024, at approximately 10:45pm, in the 3500 Block of N. Charles Street. Two affiliates were walking in the area when a small white four door SUV type vehicle approached the affiliates. Two subjects wearing black ski masks exited the vehicle and demanded the affiliates cell phone and backpack, which they complied. The two subjects then entered the vehicle and fled South bound on Charles Street. The affiliates were not injured.

In another incident Baltimore Police are investigating an assault that occurred on November 19, 2024 at approximately 10:55pm. An affiliate was in the area of the 100 block of University Parkway when a small white four door SUV type vehicle approached the affiliate. One subject wearing a ski mask exited the vehicle and assaulted the affiliate. The suspect got back into the vehicle and fled the area.

4-5 male juveniles, 15-17 years old, wearing ski masks

A small four door white in color SUV type vehicle
