PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a robbery that occurred in the 2900 block of N. Charles Street, on December 8, 2024, at about 1:10PM. At this time, an affiliate was walking along N. Charles Street when they were approached by three males. Two males were riding scooters, and one male was riding a bicycle.

As the males reached the affiliate's location, they stopped and demanded the affiliate's jacket, and they complied. All three males subsequently fled southbound on N. Charles Street. No weapons were displayed and the affiliate did not sustain any injuries during the incident.

Suspect Descriptions:

Three males, 12-15 years of age, wearing dark clothing

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
