PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are investigating two incidents that occurred on January 2, 2025, between 12:47 PM and 1:30 PM. The incidents occurred in the 2900 block of Howard Street and the rear of Croft Hall. In these incidents, two affiliates were walking when a male suspect approached them from the rear. The suspect then, unsuccessfully, tried to take property from the affiliates. After each of these incidents, the suspect fled the area. The affiliates were not injured in either incident. Baltimore Police and Public Safety responded and began an investigation which led them to the 2900 Block of Aisquith Street. There, the suspect was located and arrested by Baltimore Police.

Suspect Description

Male, 20-25 years old, 5'6, thin, wearing black mask, black parka jacket with a grey and black hoodie.
