PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police and the Johns Hopkins Public Safety Department are investigating three separate incidents of attempted thefts. These incidents occurred between January 30, 2025 10:00 PM and January 31, 2025 12:00 AM. These incidents occurred in the areas of the 3500 Block N. Charles Street, the 100 Block of University Parkway and 33rd and St. Paul Streets. The affiliates were approached by 2 males riding a moped. The suspects demanded property, but no property was turned over. There were no weapons displayed nor were any of the affiliates injured.
