PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating a Commercial Armed Robbery that occurred at 3003 N. Charles Street (7-11 Convenience Store) on July 22, 2025, at about 5:42 AM. A male suspect entered the store and approached the clerk and implied he had a weapon. The suspect jumped over the counter taking several packs of cigarettes and candy. The suspect fled the area on foot in an unknown direction. No injuries reported at the scene.

Suspect Description: Male, 25-27 yrs., Black coat, Black pants, possibly wearing a wig.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
