PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating an attempted robbery that occurred in the 3100 block of Lovegrove Street on July 26, 2025, at about 6:25AM. At this time, an affiliate was walking along Lovegrove Street when they were approached by a black vehicle. As the vehicle parked on Lovegrove Street, two subjects exited and approached the affiliate.

The subjects attempted to take the affiliate's property, but were unsuccessful. The subjects returned to the vehicle and fled southbound on Lovegrove Street. No weapons were displayed, and no injuries were reported at the scene.

Subject Descriptions:

Subject #1: male, 5'7", 155-160 lbs., black hooded sweatshirt and black mask

Subject #2: male, 5'10", 250 lbs., brown sweater and black mask

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
