PUBLIC SAFETY ADVISORY

To keep you informed:

Baltimore Police are currently investigating two incidents which occurred on November 9, 2025 at approximately 2:15 PM. The first incident occurred at 29th and Guilford Avenue. An affiliate was approached from behind by 3 male suspects. One of the suspects struck the affiliate in the back of the head taking their food items. The second incident occurred in the rear of the 2900 block of N. Calvert Street. The non-affiliate was exiting their vehicle when 3 male suspects approached the non-affiliate. The suspects demanded the car keys, then assaulted the non-affiliate. The non-affiliate fled the area. The suspects fled the area without taking any property.

Suspect Description: Group of 3 males all wearing dark clothing.

Homewood Public Safety would like everyone to be aware of this incident and remind everyone that should you find yourself the victim of a robbery, do not resist and do not pursue suspects. Always remember to stay calm, listen, observe intently, surrender any requested property and report the crime as soon as possible.
